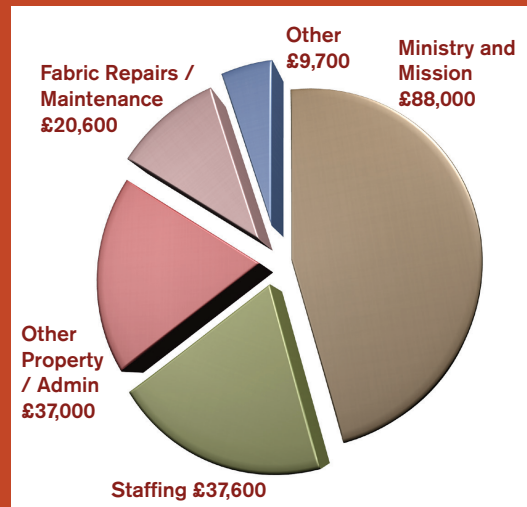

Church Costs 2015

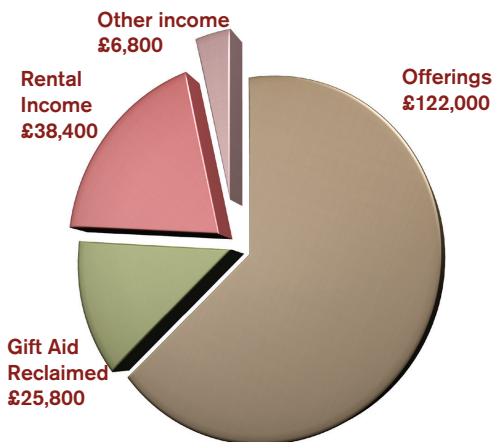
